<u>Recommended Action</u>: Upon Executive Committee recommendation, approve the attached Proposed Radio Policy and Procedures as presented.

Background: A pending task in the Executive Officer's 2011 Work Plan was to formalize a MERA Radio Policy and Procedures with input from Operations Officer Mansourian and his DPW team. Attached is the proposed policy and procedures which reflect their input and Board-approved practice.

The MERA Finance Committee was briefed on this matter at their May 25, 2011 meeting in conjunction with the proposed Non-member System User Fee Schedule. The proposed policy and procedures was distributed to the Finance Committee prior to submission to the Executive Committee on September 14, 2011.

Once adopted, this document will be posted on MERA's website (meraonline.org) for members, staff and public reference.

Additional Radios Policy and Procedures

<u>Purpose</u>: To e

To establish operational and administrative requirements for the addition of member and non-member mobile and portable radios for use on the MERA system.

Policy:

The Marin Emergency Radio Authority operates a radio system that facilitates essential communications between and among its member agencies and non-member public and private users that serve and support all facets of public safety. The MERA Operations Officer will review all requests for additional radios and make a recommendation to the Executive Committee.

Procedures:

- 1. A member or non-member agency must submit a written request for additional radios to the Operations Officer for his review and recommendation to the Executive Committee.
- 2. If a request is deemed urgent by the Operations Officer, he will make his determination and report back to the Executive Committee with his decision.
- 3. Public and private agencies not members of the Authority may use the radio system on a fee basis upon formal request and approval of the Operations Officer and Executive Committee. The fee schedule for the use of the system by non-members will be reviewed and approved annually by the Board as part of the annual operating budget.
- 4. Review of requests for additional radios will take into account the affects on system capacity and radio usage.
- 5. The regulatory agency pays for replacement and additional mobile and portable radios and all costs associated with programming and alignment. Training is separate and is not included with additional or replacement radio costs.

MERA Mobile and Portable Radios

The original <u>system design</u> subscriber count was for 1580 units with a projected 20 year growth total count of 1896 units. We are 914 units above the 20 year projection.
