 Bayhill now has a building permit. Will start construction next week.
- B. Adopt minutes of August 26, 2004. M/S – To adopt minutes of August 26, 2004 – Approved

- D. Mt. Tiburon:
 - 1) Report from the Negotiating Committee. (J. Bonander, D. Hunter & D. Whitson)
 - Committee met with Town and neighbors on September 22, 2004.
 - All agreed Mt. Tiburon is to be built.
 - Agreed to study Wolfback Ridge as a single site alternative to Mt. Tiburon.
 - Any two-site alternative is too expensive to for further consideration.
 - Wolfback must be able to receive coverage and warranty guarantees from Motorola.
 - Angel Island no longer under consideration because of cost and permitting issues.
 - If Wolfback can meet coverage and warranty requirements, it would be constructed to replace Mt. Tiburon.
 - Cost of replacement shared one-third MERA and two-thirds Town and neighbors.
 - 2) Adoption of an alternate site policy.

Motion:

- 1. Authorize staff working w/Motorola to analyze a MERA facility on Wolfback Ridge that is compatible w/Motorola coverage and warranty guarantee and can be licensed by the FCC.
- 2. Determine the costs of the new site.
- 3. Agree to abandoned Mt. Tiburon once the new Wolfback Ridge site becomes operational.
- 4. Conceptually agree to share the net cost of the new site one-third MERA two-thirds Tiburon and neighbors at a total cost not-to-exceed \$900,000.
- 5. Study on Wolfback Ridge feasibility to be completed by December 31, 2004.
- 6. Written agreements to be prepared between MERA & Tiburon to specify testing goals, criteria and costs and how MERA would proceed to abandon Mt. Tiburon once Wolfback is Operational.
- 7. Such agreement to be brought back for approval of the Board of Directors.
