This is a formal request from KWMR, West Marin Community Radio, to waive the current Annual License Fee for the use of MERA sites at Mt. Vision and Martinelli Bolinas. The fee for each site is currently \$1,080 for a total annual fee of \$2,160 annually.

KWMR is very grateful to be a community partner with local first responders in disseminating verified information on road closures, power outages, and weather and disasters. The radio station takes our role in both disaster preparedness and information dissemination very seriously.

The station works closely with both Marin County Fire (where we are colocated at Mt. Barnabe in Lagunitas) as well as with local volunteer fire departments, the Office of the Marin County Sheriff and the local Disaster Coordinators. KWMR was on the air within minutes of the 2014 Napa earthquake. The station broadcast updates from local first responders in West Marin and then took calls from around the North Bay. We were the only live broadcast entity for more than 45 minutes after the quake.

KWMR also broadcast upwards of ten minutes per hour of information regarding the North Bay fires this past fall. The station worked closely with Marin County Public Information Officers and the office of Supervisor Dennis Rodoni to inform the community about the situation at hand locally and with our partners in counties to the north.

This waiver of the fee will help KWMR, by reducing expenses. As a nonprofit 501c3 organization that relies on contributions from listeners and members, this financial relief will go a long way.
