MARIN EMERGENCY RADIO AUTHORITY (MERA)

Scope of Services.

- 1. Commencing April 1, 2019, RGS will assign an employee or employees to perform financial services needed to support the transition of Agency operations to a new location.
- 2. RGS shall assign an RGS employee or employees to perform the functions as described below, and as approved by Agency:
 - Perform the functions as assigned by the RGS lead advisor.
 - Provide services on an as needed basis, with appropriate invoices for services provided.
 - Services may be within any of the RGS service areas, including but not limited to:
 Human Resources Consultation, Benefit Administration, Project and Transitional
 Management, Community Engagement/Communication Services, Land Use
 Planning Services, Finance Consultation, Training Design and Delivery, Strategic
 Planning and Facilitation Services, Emergency Management Consultation.
 - Services to be engaged via task work order or amendment to this agreement.
 - Be reasonably available to perform the services during the normal work week.
 - Meet regularly and as often as necessary for the purpose of consulting about the scope of work performed with the appropriate Agency project manager and with RGS lead.
 - Perform other duties as are consistent with the services described herein and approved by the RGS lead advisor.
 - Perform related work as required as approved by the RGS lead advisor.
 - Such employee may perform services at Agency offices available or at other locations.
