October 2019 Governing Board UPDATE:

- A public hearing on the Draft SEIR was conducted by MERA on October 10, 2019 from 6:00pm to 8:00pm in the Board of Supervisors Chambers 3501 Civic Center Drive - Room #330. No public comments were made and only one member of the public attended.
- The Draft Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (SEIR) was available for public review and comment until 4:00pm on 10/21/19. Now that the public comment period has ended, MERA will be reviewing all comments received, preparing responses, and developing the Final SEIR for Governing Board consideration at a future meeting.
- The Next Gen Project Oversight Committee has reviewed Change Order #8 and Motorola's recommendation to upgrade the operating system of the Next Gen Project to Multi-Protocol Label Switching for microwave network in comparison to the original recommendation of the Layer-2 System. The Next Gen Project Oversight Committee recommended both Option 1 (MPLS with Service Upgrade Agreement) and Option 4a (MPLS without Service Upgrade Agreement) and following Finance Committee and further Governing Board review, this item is scheduled for consideration at the 10/23/19 Governing Board meeting.
