LOW-INCOME SENIOR EXEMPTIONS

Recommended Action: Receive and file Report on Measure A Low-Income Senior Exemptions.

Background: Since the passage of Measure A on November 4, 2014, and the first year's application of the parcel tax on the County Assessor's Tax Rolls in FY15-16, the numeric breakdown for approved exemption applications due each June 1 is as follows:

FY15-16	113
FY16-17	128
FY17-18	119
FY18-19	136
FY19-20	135
FY20-21	205

As reported previously under your regular Next Gen Project updates, 3 Media Advisories on the exemption process are released monthly prior to each annual deadline.

Information on the exemption is posted on the MERA website homepage.

Purpose of the annual exemption application is to address changes in age and income eligibility from year to year.
