 - i. Motorola developing Code Plugs for NG radios.
 - ii. Code Plugs includes assigning of individual radio ID numbers and system ID's for each talkgroup.

7) New Construction Change Orders for Bid Package #3 and #4: No new Change Orders were presented by Fidato since your last meeting. We do anticipate additional change orders being addressed at your December Governing Board meeting.

8) Construction Support Vendors:

As part of monitoring the construction project and MERA's ability to self-permit and inspect work, MERA hired a variety of firms to perform that work. As construction nears its end, we are reviewing each contract and can safely close two of those contracts at this time.

- a. Phillips-Seabrook (Plan-Checks). This contract was originally approved for \$20,000, with an additional \$15,000 approved later in the project. At this point, we have not used Phillips-Seabrook since 10/2022. We have requested the return of our \$5,000 retainer. This retainer and the remaining balance of \$2,792.50 can be considered unencumbered and available for other project needs.
- b. Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria (FIGR) (Tribal Issues). This contract was originally approved for \$9,000, with an additional \$40,000 approved later in the project. At this point, we have not used the FIGR since June 2023 and do not anticipate any further need. The remaining balance of \$36,531.62 can be considered unencumbered and available for other project needs.
- c. Total unencumbered with this report: \$44,324.12.
- d. We anticipate releasing additional funds at the December Governing Board meeting.
